Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one (1)** new positive case of COVID-19, and **two (2)** recoveries. We are also recording an adjustment to yesterday’s numbers – our local DSHS office has informed us that there was a glitch in the Texas Health Trace system which caused 10 cases to be added in error. Sadly, we have been notified of **one (1)** additional fatality due, thus our total number of COVID-19 confirmed deaths is now **forty-eight (48)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **twenty-five (25)**, that does NOT include any probables.
