Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seven (7)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **no (0)** recoveries. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities, thus our total number of COVID-19 confirmed deaths remains at **forty-eight (48)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **thirty-two (32)**, that does NOT include any probables.
