Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **sixteen (16)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** new recoveries to report.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now **three hundred thirty-five (335)** in Wharton County and we have had **eighty-nine (89)** reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **two hundred forty-five (245)** active COVID-19 cases. *Tentative new testing dates are Tuesday & Wednesday, July 21-22 in Wharton, and Thursday, July 23 in El Campo. More details to follow.*

The recent upward trend in positive cases means we *must* remain diligent in our efforts to slow the spread of this disease. Now is not the time to let up on our social-distancing practices! **Take personal responsibility** and **do your part:** continue to avoid crowds, wear masks pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order and use good common sense when out in the community.
