Wharton County, TX, Friday, September 18, 2020 1200 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **nine (9)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **nine (9)** recoveries to report. With 1 more adjustment, our confirmed cases are now **one thousand three hundred eighty-one (1,381)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred sixty-two (1,262)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **eighty (80)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for next Tuesday, September 22 at the Wharton City Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
