Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **sixteen (16)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** recoveries to report. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand three hundred ninety-eight (1,398)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred sixty-three (1,263)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **ninety-six (96)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing has been CANCELLED for tomorrow, Tuesday, September 22 at the Wharton City Civic Center. We will announce the next testing opportunity after dates have been confirmed.
