Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, September 23, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **nine (9)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** recoveries to report. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred seventeen (1,417)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred eighty-four (1,284)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **ninety-four (94)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing was CANCELLED this week because of Tropical Storm Beta. We will announce the next testing opportunity after dates have been confirmed.
