## Wharton County, TX, Friday, October 2, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **six (6)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **ten (10)** recoveries. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred fifty-six (1,456)** and we have had **one thousand three hundred fifty-six (1,356)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **sixty-one (61)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, Octoer 6, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.
