Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **six (6)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **twenty-five (25)** recoveries. Sadly. we have been notified of **one (1)** additional fatality, thus our total number of COVID-19 confirmed deaths is now **forty-nine (49)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **twenty-nine (29)**, that does NOT include any probables.
