Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **fifteen (15)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **ten (10)** recoveries to report. There are **two (2)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **forty-five (45)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand ninety-three (1,093)** in Wharton County and we have had **four hundred eight (408)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **six hundred fifty-nine (659)** active COVID-19 cases. Sadly, we also received a report of an additional **eight (8)** fatalities due to COVID-19 bringing the total number of deaths to **twenty-six (26)**.

IMPORTANT: The next scheduled county-wide testing will be next Tuesday, August 25, 8 AM – 4 PM, at Wharton Civic Center. Registration info will be forthcoming.
