Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **twenty-five (25)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **six (6)** recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **fifty-three (53)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand one hundred sixty-eight (1,168)** in Wharton County and we have had **four hundred forty-nine (449)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **six hundred ninety-one (691)** active COVID-19 cases. **No (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at **twenty-eight (28)**.
