Wharton County, TX, Tuesday, September 22, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **eleven (11)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **twenty-one (21)** recoveries to report. With one (1) adjustment, our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred eight (1,408)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred eighty-four (1,284)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **eighty-five (85)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing has been CANCELLED for today, Tuesday, September 22 at the Wharton City Civic Center. We will announce the next testing opportunity after dates have been confirmed.
