Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, October 7, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **seven (7)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **fourteen (14)** recoveries. Our confirmed cases are now **one thousand four hundred seventy-five (1,475)** and we have had **one thousand three hundred seventy-nine (1,379)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **fifty-seven (57)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be Tuesday, October 13, at the City of Wharton Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.
