MINUTES OF CITY OF WHARTON SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING JUNE 10, 2014

Mayor Pro-Tem Don Mueller declared a Special Meeting duly open for the transaction of business at 6:00 P.M.

The third item discussed on the agenda was to review and consider Employee Health Insurance Benefits. City Manager Andres Garza, Jr. stated that the City Staff had been working with the Texas Municipal League MultiState – Intergovernmental Employee Benefits Pool (TML MultiState-IEBP) for the rates for next fiscal year. City Secretary Paula Favors stated the increase in premiums was going to be 7% with the plan remaining the same. She then presented the proposed rate increase:

City Manager Andres Garza, Jr. stated that the City Staff was recommending the City Council consider remaining with Texas Municipal League MultiState – IEBP and contributing to the employee flex plan for those eligible in the amount of \$750, as was being done in the current fiscal year. After some discussion, Councilmember Al Bryant moved to approve remaining with Texas Municipal League MultiState – Intergovernmental Employee benefits Pool (TML MultiState-IEBP) and contribute to the flex contribution for eligible employees in the amount of \$750 a year. Councilmember Tim Barker seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
