City of Wharton Hurricane Beryl Debris Collection Wrap Up

Wharton, TX, August 9, 2024 –

The City of Wharton's debris collection contractor has started to wrap up collection from Hurricane Beryl. All storm-related debris should have been moved to the right of way as of Friday, August 9, 2024. The City of Wharton's debris collection contractor has begun marking all ineligible debris piles with a fluorescent orange X. All freshly cut vegetative debris is considered ineligible and will be identified by the orange X. The ineligible debris will be picked up by Green for Life (GFL) when normal brush pickup resumes. The ineligible debris must be cut into four-foot lengths per City Ordinance for collection.

As always for proper and timely collection, please ensure that all tree limb debris is kept separate from any other garbage. If you have anything mixed with limbs such as construction debris or metal items, it will not be collected. If you have bagged leaves and small limbs, the bags must be placed separately from limb piles. We ask for your patience during this time.
