For the period of May 19-May 25, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-six (36)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **forty-one (41)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **4.34%**.

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 testing is being conducted tomorrow, WEDNESDAY, MAY 26, at the WHARTON CIVIC CENTER, from 8 am - 4 pm. Vaccination clinics are still being held - today at East Bernard, tomorrow at Boling & in Wharton at Oakbend Hospital. You must register for the Oakbend clinic at oakbendmedcenter.org.
