**For the period of September 27 – October 3, 2021**, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **eighty-seven (87)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **12.13%**.

Sadly, we must report that since September 26, **six (6)** more of our residents have succumbed to this disease, bringing our total to **one hundred sixty-three (163)**.
