Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred nineteen (119)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **sixty-three (63)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **18.72%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is next Tuesday, January 12, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is <https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening> The test is free.
