President Herman Wolff, Jr. declared a Regular Meeting duly open for the transaction of business at 7:00 P.M.

Boards of Directors present were: Herman Wolff, Jr.; Marc Sangalli; Marvin Koliba; Gary

Bonewald, and Adraylle Watson.

Board of Directors absent were: None.

Visitors present were: Attorney Howard Singleton, City of Wharton EMS

Director Christy Gonzales, City of Wharton Finance Director Joan Andel, and City of Wharton City Secretary

Paula Favors.

The second item on the agenda was a roll call and excused absences. All members were present.

The third item on the agenda was public comments. No comments were given. No action was taken.

The fourth item on the agenda was the reading of the minutes from the regular meeting held on May 9, 2024. After some discussion, Boardmember Marvin Koliba moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on May 9, 2024. Boardmember Marc Sangalli seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The fifth item on the agenda was the City of Wharton's Financial Report for ESD No. 3 and the EMS Department. City of Wharton Finance Director Joan Andel stated that the ESD No. 3 financial statement as of May 31, 2024, had revenues of \$2,050,327 and Expenditures of \$1,986,237. After some discussion, Boardmember Gary Bonewald made a motion to accept the financial report. Boardmember Marvin Koliba seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The sixth item on the agenda was the ESD No. 3 Funds Investment Report. City of Wharton Finance Director Joan Andel stated as of May 31, 2024, the cash and investments at First State Bank consisted of a cash balance of \$246,735.70 at First State Bank, \$213,188.63 at Prosperity Bank; a \$220,000 C.D.; a \$20,000 Money Market account, and \$425.49 in Shares/Savings at Texasgulf Credit Union. As of June 5th, 2024, cash and investments at First State Bank consisted of a \$130,000 Money Market account; \$112,000.00 C.D., and a Checking of \$27,346.71. After some discussion, Boardmember Adraylle Watson made a motion to accept the financial report. Boardmember Marc Sangalli seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The seventh item on the agenda was the report on the interest rates available for the ESD Reserve Funds. City of Wharton Finance Director Joan Andel presented a report on the interest rates available for ESD Funds. After some discussion, no action was taken.

ESD No. 3 Regular Meeting June 13, 2024

The eighth item on the agenda was designating the City of Wharton Finance Director to access banking information for all Wharton County ESD No. 3 accounts and allow online banking. City of Wharton Finance Director Joan Andel stated she was requesting the Board consider approving her access to banking information for all of the Wharton County ESD No. 3 accounts to allow her to complete the day-to-day business as needed and allowing online banking access. She said the access would be a view only access and not any financial changes. After some discussion, Boardmember Marvin Koliba moved to approve designating the City of Wharton Finance Director to access banking information view only for all Wharton County ESD No. 3 accounts and allow online banking. Boardmember Gary Bonewald seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The ninth item discussed on the agenda was the City of Wharton Emergency Medical Services Report. City of Wharton Assistant EMS Director Christy Gonzales addressed the Board and presented the monthly report for May 2024, which reflected:
