A tax rate of \$0.08197 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Emergency Services District #3.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Emergency Services District #3 from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Emergency Services District #3 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Emergency Services District #3 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 11, 2025 AT 7:00 p.m AT 120 E Caney St., Wharton, Tx 77488.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Emergency Services District #3 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Emergency Services District #3 at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
